SCHOOL UNIFORM

HEAD LICE

There have been a few cases of head lice being identified at school. The office does have a limited supply of treatments for students and whānau. It is important for whānau to check their children as head lice can spread in a communal setting such as a school.

We will be in contact with the public health nurse to help support whānau who need help with this issue.

YEAR 7 & 8 IMMUNISATIONS

As part of the National Immunisation Schedule, students will be offered the following vaccinations at the end of Term One:

Year 7 students are offered Boostrix, to protect against tetanus, diphtheria and whooping cough.

Year 8 students are offered Gardasil 9, a vaccine that offers protection against most cancers caused by HPV.

This week, all Year 7 and 8 students will be given information and a form to take home, complete and return to school. Please return this to school even if you choose NOT to have your child vaccinated. This prevents any confusion, as we know the form has been seen by a parent or guardian.

JUNIOR TECHNOLOGY

All students who have Food Technology and Hard Materials classes need to wear covered shoes during these lessons. Students may also bring a mufti shirt for the workshop but must change back into their school polo before leaving the class.
